FACTS ABOUT HOMELESS WOMEN

- 10. Common risk factors associated with homeless women include poverty, housing instability, work problems and victimization.
- 9. Homeless women can divided into two subgroups: women with children and single homeless women.
- 8. Single homeless women are more likely to be white, homeless longer, and more often have a history of alcoholism and schizophrenia than homeless women with children.
- 7. Single families headed by women is the fastest growing population of homeless.
- 6. The average ago of homeless mothers is in their late twenties.
- 5. Homeless women often need emotional support as the majority are not receiving support from their families and many are victims of domestic violence.
- 4. Social workers need to help homeless women by connecting them with needed resources.
- 3. The current welfare reform is likely to increase the homeless population but some service providers are using it as a motivational tool.
- 2. Successful programs use community resources such as churches and volunteer organization to assist with service provision.
- 1. Changes are needed at the macro level in the provision of affordable housing, job training and adequate financial assistance to decrease the homeless population.
