While being treated at the hospital, a child is provided a comprehensive therapy program, which includes the family. More specifically, treatment involves individual, family, and group therapy, therapeutic activities, and individualized academic instruction. Medication therapy is also available if necessary.
- A partial hospitalization program is available for children and adolescents.
- A Crisis Evaluation Bed Service (with a maximum stay of 23 hours) is available to assess acute need situations in which admission to the hospital may not be required.

- HealthSouth is a full-service inpatient hospital solely for the purpose of rehabilitation. Patients who are admitted have a variety of conditions from stroke, heart attack, closed head injury, cancer, brain surgery, spinal cord injury, and other causes of debilitation. - The Behavioral Health Center has two inpatient programs: THE ADULT PSYCHIATRIC PROGRAM for persons 18-64 with a mental health diagnosis and the SENIOR ADULT PROGRAM for persons 65 and older with a mental health diagnosis. The staff includes psychiatrists, psychiatric nurses, social workers, therapeutic recreational specialists and occupational therapy. TriHealth (cont) Specialized nursing home services include: monthly or more frequently visits to the facilities to see patients, 24 hour on call availability, acute hospitalization admission if indicated, education and training to facility staff, continuing education hours offered to professional staff, family support services on site at facility, monthly education mailing sent to each facility for in-service training regarding the mental health needs of older adults, and liaison staff provided to meet with nursing home staff regarding developing and implementing mental health interventions for the resident's plan of care.
