### **FAIRHAVEN MISSION**

- Offers a hot meal every evening at 6 pm. Provides shelter for up to 25 men with access to showers and laundry facilities (must have picture ID). Offers chapel services, bible study, and women's workshops. Thrift store at 9th and Philadelphia where people can purchase clothing. Clothing vouchers are available for men, women and children. Long term (no time limit) Homeless Rehabilitation Program for men that involve spiritual guidance and employment assistance. Emergency Assistance with clothing and groceries. Provides an after school program for children.

### **HOMEWARD BOUND RUNAWAY SHELTER**

- Temporary shelter for teenage runaways from 11-17 years of age. Provides shelter, meals, and counseling. Staff works with the child and family in a ten-day period to refer them to resources and identify the problem. Staff includes a child abuse specialist, youth specialist, and chemical dependency specialist. Open 24 hours, 7 days a week. Maximum stay is 8 months if in treatment program.

- Maplewood Children's Home is an emergency shelter/residential treatment facility licensed by the State of Ky. to house both boys and girls ranging in age from birth to 18 years of age with a capacity of 29 children. Maplewood provides services to children that have been abused, neglected, or are otherwise dependent, and for status offenses--children who are runaways, beyond the control of their parents or truant.

- Shelter for homeless women and children (maximum of 30 people). The shelter provides shared bedrooms, a common kitchen and TV room, laundry facilities, and a children's room. Participants receive 3 meals a day; personal hygiene and baby care items, and bus transportation. Also provides emergency assistance with clothing and food. Protective payee, stabilization and self-sufficiency programs.

**WOMEN'S CRISIS CENTER****491-3335**

- Provides safe shelter for women and children who are victims of domestic violence or sexual abuse. Also provides related services such as counseling, advocacy, and referrals for employment and housing. Group activities primarily address sexual assault and domestic violence, but also include single parenting, self-esteem, health, and nutrition.

- Shelter for homeless families (men, women, and children) only, no singles. Does accept boys up to 18 if in school.

- Shelter for men only. Drug and alcohol residential rehabilitation program for women (six months-one year +). Provides clubs, training and speakers for women. Clothing for men, women and children. Emergency food baskets available by appointment only.

- Shelter for single men and women 19 and over. No families accepted unless extreme emergency (will accept if night, but need to go elsewhere in morning). Also provides food, clothing, and a weekly medical van, 3 meals a day, and showers. Curfew 10:00 pm.

Also provides group and individual counseling, crisis prevention, violence prevention, and budgeting skills.
